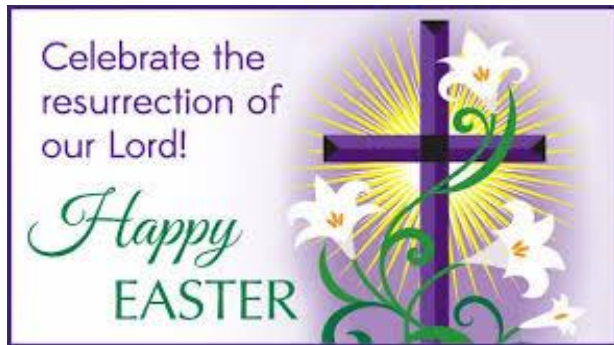

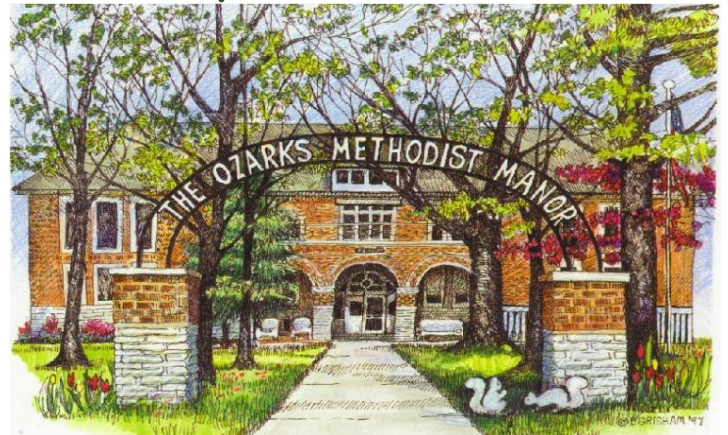
Brandi Harris, CMT

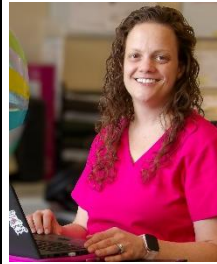
