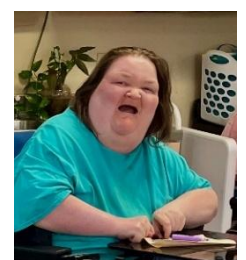
Milk Filter Doll Fundraiser

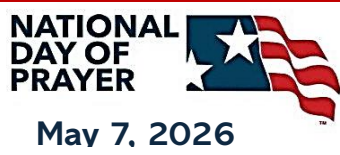
News from "The Green Room" (a.k.a. The Sweat Shop)
